CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

Rules and Regulations:

Students of Shangpung College are expected to follow the General Regulations and other rules of discipline set by the college.

- 1. Every student should possess an Identity Card and the same is to be maintained in good condition and easily accessible for verification by college staffs.
- 2. Punctuality and Regular Attendance is insisted upon. Attendance will be monitored daily and a minimum attendance percentage (75 %) is mandatory to be eligible for exams or extracurricular activities.
- 3. Students are expected to dress neatly and maintain a clean and presentable appearance at all times on campus. Clothing should be appropriate for academic environment and students must avoid wearing clothes that are too revealing, provocative or distracting to others.
- 4. The college has zero tolerance towards ragging in any form and is strictly prohibited and will not be tolerated under any circumstances. Students indulging in ragging or encourage the same will be rusticated from the college and in case of serious ragging incidents; students may face penalties such as expulsion from the college. The college reserves the right to report severe cases of ragging to law enforcement authorities which may result in criminal charges, fines or imprisonment under the Anti-Ragging law (as per the UGC guidelines and Supreme Court of India directives)
- 5. Students are required to treat all College property including classrooms, benches, furniture, equipments and infrastructures with care and respect. These resources are shared by everyone and must be preserved for the benefit of current and future students. Any form of writing or carving on desks, walls, or any other College property is deemed an offense and students engaging in such activities will face penalties.
- 6. Mobile phones may be brought to the College; however, students are required to keep these devices either turned off or set to silent mode while inside the campus. The use of mobile phones within the College building is prohibited. The College

takes no responsibility for the loss of mobile phones on campus and students who fail to adhere to these regulations will have their devices confiscated.

- 7. Smoking, consumption of alcohol, tobacco and drugs in any form is strictly prohibited. Therefore disciplinary measures will be implemented, which may include warnings, counselling, parental involvement and even suspension depending on the severity of the violation.
- 8. Students are not to spit or litter in and around the College campus.
