
#### **i. TRAINING PROGRAMMES ATTENDED BY FACULTY MEMBERS OF THE COLLEGE:**

**1. Regular Activities:**



- iv. As part of our outreach program, a cleaning drive of the Shangpung weekly market was organised on the 22nd March 2023 by our Unit in the presence of the ***Dolloi of Elaka Shangpung, Shri Chanki Langbang.***
- v. On the 10/03/2023 a cleaning drive of the Umsahep, Shangpung Mission public drinking/water shed was organised by the Unit.
